Fredrik Schaufelberger is assistant professor in organic chemistry at KTH Royal Institute of Technology (Stockholm, Sweden). He received his PhD in bioorganic supramolecular chemistry from the same institution in 2017, and the same year he moved to the group of Prof. David A. Leigh at the University of Manchester with a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Individual Fellowship to study molecular machines and mechanically interlocked molecules. After a research stay with Prof. Molly M. Stevens at Imperial College London where he was investigating new drug delivery platforms and bioimaging methodologies, he took up his current position at KTH in late 2021. His group studies mechanically interlocked molecules for applications in biomedicine and biomaterials.
