While working for IBM Research, Philippe completed an MPhil degree at the University of Cambridge and a PhD in Chemistry and Molecular Sciences with the Reymond group at the University of Bern. In February 2022, Philippe joined EPFL as a tenure-track assistant professor at the Institute of Chemical Sciences and Engineering. He leads the Laboratory of Artificial Chemical Intelligence ([LIAC](#)), which works on AI-accelerated discovery and synthesis of molecules. Philippe is also a core PI of the NCCR Catalysis, a Swiss centre for sustainable chemistry research, education, and innovation, and a co-lead of the Science Pillar in the Swiss AI Initiative.
