Midori Akiyama is a Unit Leader at RIKEN Center for Emergent Matter Science (CEMS). She received her Ph.D. from the University of Tokyo in 2017 under the supervision of Prof. Kyoko Nozaki. In the same year, she joined the Laboratory for Material and Life Sciences for Fusion of Fluorine and Organic Chemistry at the University of Tokyo as a Project Assistant Professor. She then moved to Prof. Hiroshi Imahori's group at Kyoto University as an Assistant Professor in 2022. In April 2026, she established her independent research group at RIKEN CEMS. She has received the L'Oréal-UNESCO For Women in Science Japan Fellowships (2017), the Thieme Chemistry Journals Award (2023), the PCCP Prize (2023), and the CSJ Award for Young Chemists (2025). Her research interests include synthetic organic chemistry, photochemistry, organometallic chemistry, and fluorine chemistry.
