Gregor S. Cremosnik studied chemistry at the University of Zurich before moving to the University of Oxford (UK) for his DPhil studies. Under the supervision of Prof. Véronique Gouverneur, he worked on the radiofluorination of natural product analogues and their precursor synthesis. In 2018, he started his postdoctoral studies with Prof. Herbert Waldmann at the Max Plank Institute of Molecular Physiology (DE) exploring the synthesis and biological characterization of pseudo-natural products. Gregor joined Novartis Biomedical Research in 2021 as a principal scientist. He supported teams across the organization in tool- and early hit finding activities using macrocyclic peptides before moving into LMW-focused projects.
