Murielle F. Delley studied Chemistry at the ETH Zürich. She obtained her PhD in 2017 from the ETH Zürich with Professor Christophe Copéret on surface-organometallic chemistry and catalysis. She then worked as a postdoc with Professor James M. Mayer at Yale on interfacial proton and electron transfers. In 2020, she started her independent research at the University of Basel with a Branco Weiss Society in Science Fellowship, a Swiss National Science Foundation (SNSF) PRIMA Fellowship, and later a SNSF Starting Grant. In 2023, she was appointed tenure-track Assistant Professor of Inorganic Chemistry. Her research group focuses on the interfacial chemistry and catalysis of inorganic materials.
