Daniele was born in Foggia, Italy. He studied chemistry at Sapienza University of Rome and the University of Bologna. After an industrial internship at Nippon Kayaku (Japan), he joined the group of Prof. Paolo Melchiorre at the Institute of Chemical Research of Catalonia (ICIQ) in Tarragona, Spain, where he obtained his PhD in 2020 working on photoexcited organocatalytic intermediates. He then carried out postdoctoral research with Prof. Timothy Noël at the University of Amsterdam as a Marie Skłodowska-Curie Fellow. In 2022 he became Assistant Professor at the University of Padova. Since 2024 he has been Tenure-Track Assistant Professor at the University of Rome Tor Vergata, where his research focuses on electrochemical and photochemical strategies for asymmetric radical transformations.

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
