

## Martin Tomanik



Martin was born in the Czech Republic and attended Dartmouth College (Hanover, NH) for his undergraduate studies. In 2016, he began his doctoral studies at Yale University (New Haven, CT) under the mentorship of Prof. Seth Herzon, focusing on total synthesis of natural products. In the summer of 2021, Martin moved to San Diego, CA to pursue postdoctoral research in the laboratory of Prof. Jin-Quan Yu at The Scripps Research Institute. In 2023, Martin joined the faculty at New York University (New York, NY) as an assistant professor in the Department of Chemistry, where his lab's research focuses on the synthesis of complex terpene and polyketides natural products and the development of new synthetic methods leveraging C–H functionalization chemistry. While at NYU, he has been the recipient of NSF CAREER Award, ACS Petroleum Research Fund (DNI) grant, and the 2026 Thieme Chemistry Journals Award.
