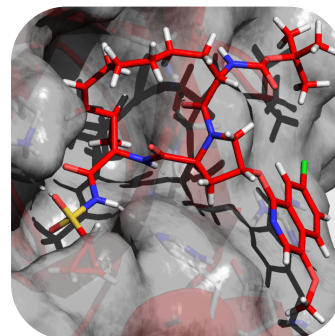
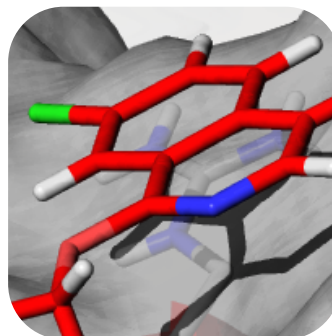

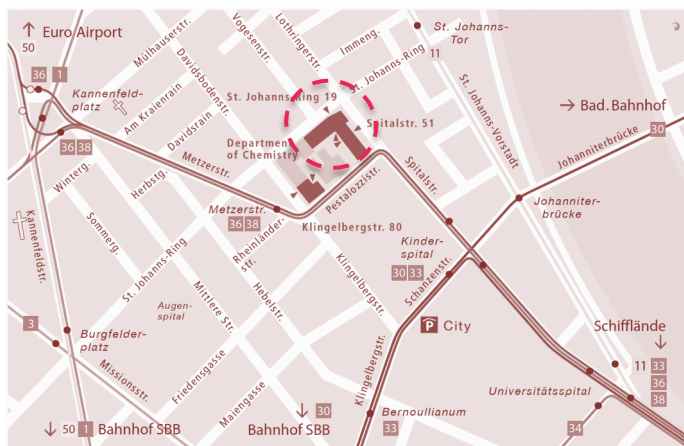
Traveling by train
