Dear participant,

Here's an update regarding the guided tour of the nuclear power plant in Mühleberg. We sent a preliminary list of participants to the operator and they accepted the whole group – 40 people registered for the event!

The operators follow a strict safety protocol concerning visitors and access to the power plant. For this reason they request more detailed information about each participant. We made their original documents available on the SCS homepage (SYCA => News => Guided tour of the nuclear power plant in Mühleberg; [LINK](#)). Since they were only provided in German, I will give a brief summary about what they say. In doubt, the original word is valid, not my translation!

We opened a google document where you can please add the requested details. The document is protected and only accessible for participants of this very event. The list must latest be handed in two weeks before the visit. Therefore the deadline is the **28-09-2017**. This is a strict deadline without any possibility for delay.

Requirements for the visit

- Bring an official identification (passport, residence permit, ID or driving license); not valid are student IDs or public transport IDs
- It is not allowed to have any electronics equipment (cell phone, camera, iPods...) during the tour (lockers are provided)
- Smoking is forbidden
- People who are under the influence of any substance are not permitted to enter the facility

Arrival by public transport

Take the S-Bahn S5 or S51 until Bern Brünnen Westside, change to Postauto (bus) line 570 (direction Mühleberg) until the stop "Fuchsried, Mühlebergwerk"; then it is approximately 20 minutes by foot (there are signs to show the way). Meeting point

To be at the meeting point on time is critical. The tour will be shortened if we arrive too late. In the interest of all participants we will therefore not delay the start of the tour. The meeting point is in front of the Cafeteria (non-public). Signs indicate the way.
