Bart DeCorte is the scientific founder of Entura, a natural products-based drug discovery venture funded by the Janssen Incubator program in Spring House, PA, where he is currently Associate Scientific Director.

In the past two decades, Bart has worked for Johnson & Johnson on three continents in the areas of HIV, mycology, oncology, pain, inflammation and metabolic disease. His most notable achievement is his co-inventorship of INTELENCE, Janssen's first FDA-approved non-nucleoside reverse transcriptase inhibitor for the treatment of HIV.

Bart joined Janssen Research Foundation in Beerse, Belgium, in 1993 as a medicinal chemist.

He completed his undergraduate education in Agricultural and Chemical Engineering at the University of Gent, Belgium, followed by graduate and postdoctoral work at the Université de Rennes, France, the University at Albany, NY, and Vanderbilt University in Nashville, TN.
