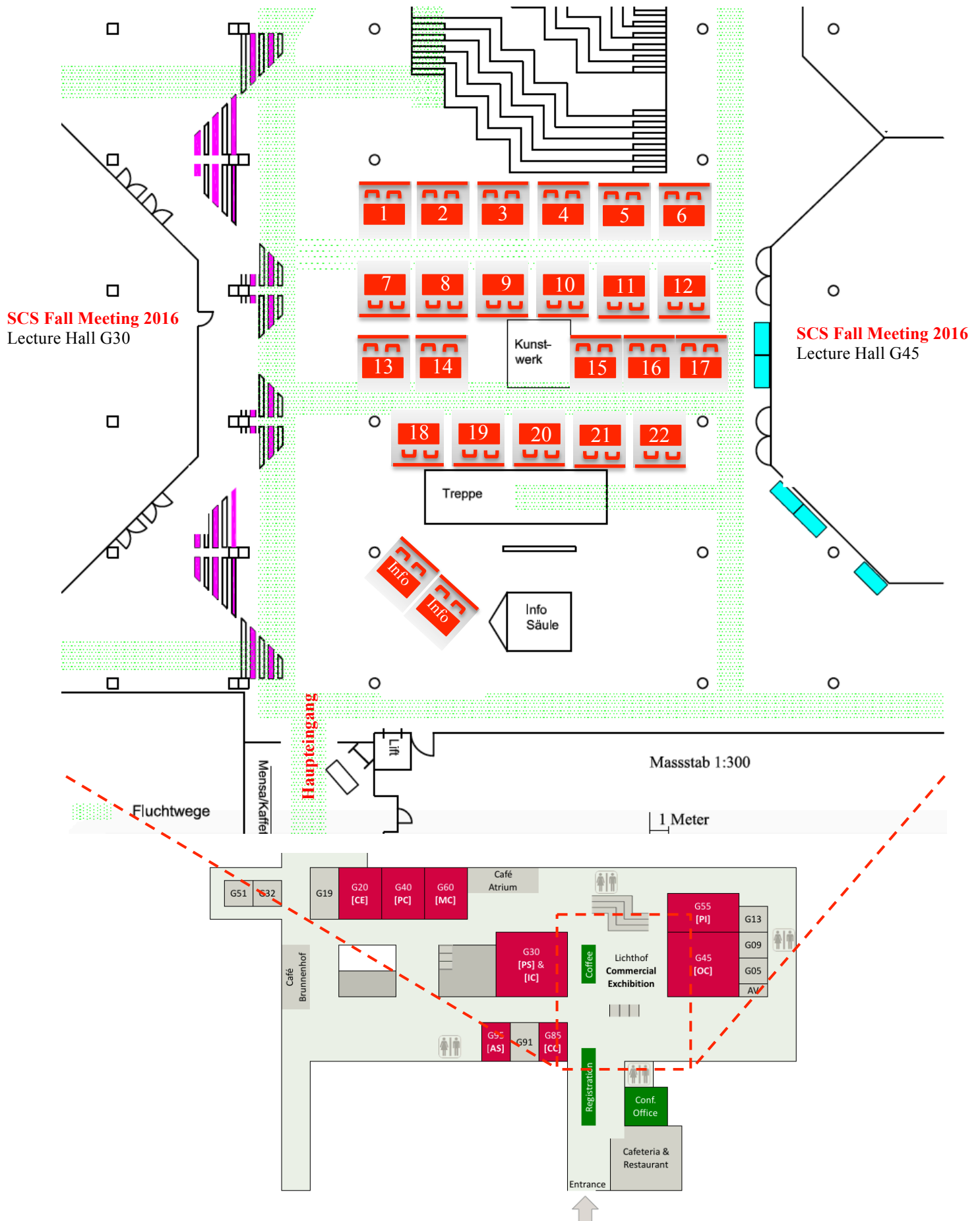

Floor Plan.

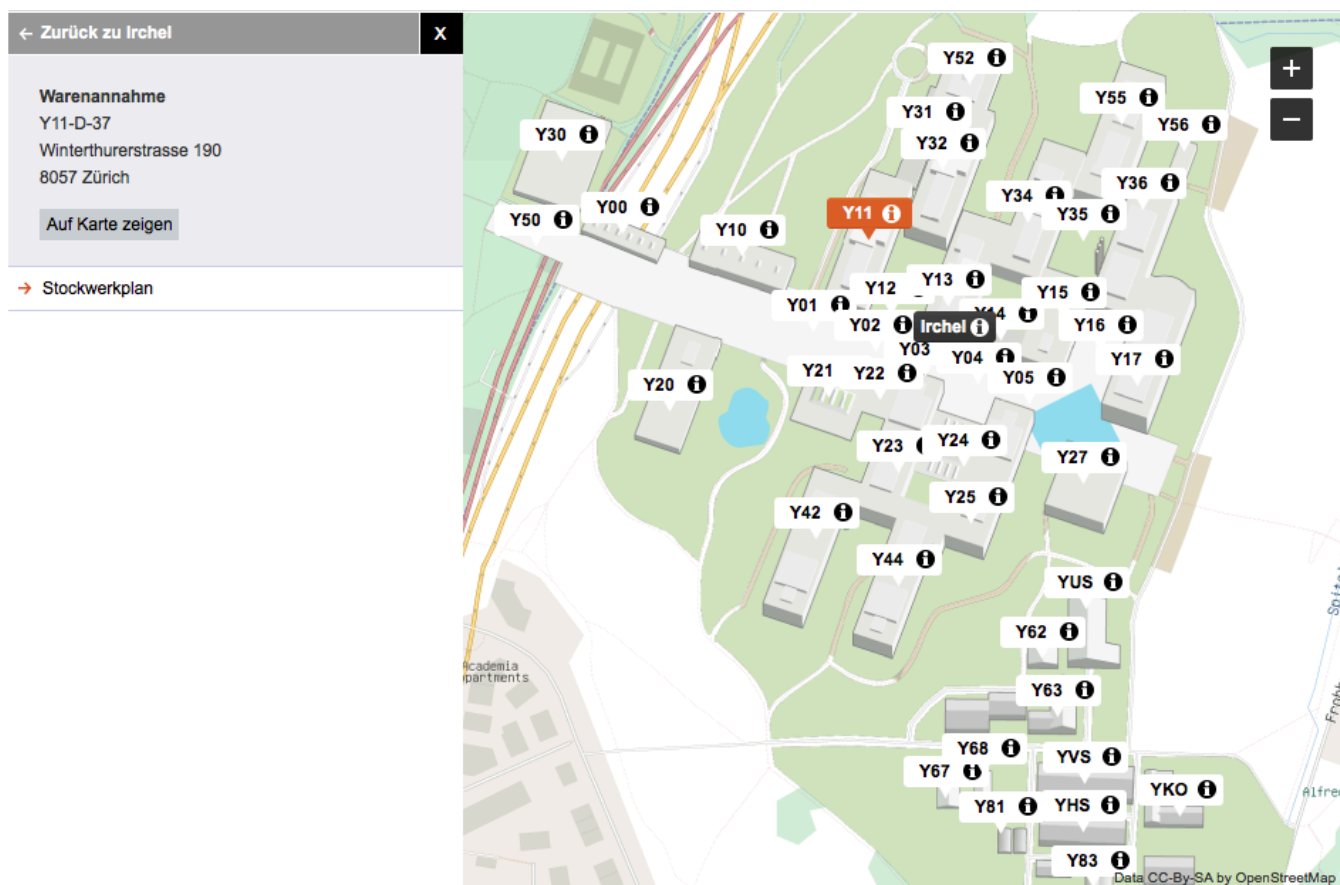
A maximum of 22 exhibitors will be considered

Standard infrastructure:
